The Caroline Foundation was set-up in memory of Caroline Dwyer-Hickey who was diagnosed with cancer when she was 26 years old.

Caroline was a patient of Prof. John Crown and became a pioneer for cancer research when she was among the first people here to participate in some drug trials through the Cancer Clinical Research Trust. This treatment not only extended her life but it increased her sense of well-being during those precious extra years. Caroline was a teacher, an amateur actor and an intrepid traveller. She was also a wife, a daughter and a sister. She was an advocate for cancer research and the importance of clinical trials in developing new ways to treat cancer.

Caroline passed away in 2013, nine years after she was first diagnosed.
